



## Seeking Teaching Assistant for Fall 2021

### Background

The Phillips Ambassadors Program, a program of the Carolina Asia Center at UNC Chapel Hill, awards a scholarship to 20-25 undergraduate students annually to study abroad in Asia. These Phillips Ambassadors attend a three credit Global Studies 281 course taught by Academic Director Dr. Michael Tsin of the History department. The program seeks to hire a graduate student to serve as teaching assistant for the course for the fall 2021 term only. Candidates should have either studied abroad in Asia or have academic/research interests in South, East and/or Southeast Asia.

Eligible candidates will be encouraged to apply separately for the 2022 Graduate Phillips Ambassador position. This student will assist with 5-6 classes in 2022 and conduct research in Asia in summer 2022. The application for this position is expected to open in late 2021.

### Duties

The fall 2021 teaching assistant will:

- Assist Academic Director during three sessions of Global Studies 281 during the fall 2021 term, to be held in person on UNC's campus on:
  - Saturday 9/25/21 8:30am-5:00pm
  - Saturday 10/30/21 8:30am-5:00pm
  - Saturday 11/13/21 8:30am-5:00pm
- Assist in grading final papers

### Eligibility

- Ph.D. candidate preferred; Master's students with significant teaching experience will be considered
- Studied abroad in Asia and/or research interests in Asia (strongly preferred)
- All majors welcome

### Stipend

A \$2500 stipend will be awarded to the fall 2021 teaching assistant. Please note that stipends are considered part of a student's overall financial aid package, are reported to the Office of Scholarships and Student Aid and are subject to tax.

### Application Process

Submit cover letter including details of any teaching experience, UNC transcript (official or unofficial), undergraduate transcripts (optional) and resume/CV to Dori Brady at [dori.brady@unc.edu](mailto:dori.brady@unc.edu) by the deadline. Letter of recommendation should be emailed directly from advisor.
